

**MORPHOSEMANTIC RELATIONS AND AGENTIVE NOUNS
IN THE BULGARIAN WORDNET****TSVETANA DIMITROVA**INSTITUTE FOR BULGARIAN LANGUAGE *PROF. L. ANDREYCHIN*

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The article describes the effort in expanding the set of morpho-semantic relations Agent and Undergoer in the Bulgarian wordnet on the basis of the assumption that verb-noun derivation largely depends on the argument structure of the predicate. Seven additional relations were manually assigned drawing upon works on classification of verbs according to their predicate-argument structure. The most productive derivational suffixes for agent-related nouns in the Bulgarian wordnet are highly agentive (additional relation of Agents), while agent-related nouns having assigned additional relations of Experiencer and Patient are mostly substantivized participles.
